## **Northside senior wins scholarship**

Ulysse Mouton, a senior at Northside High School, was recently named a Horatio Alger National Scholar.

The honor from the Horatio Alger Association includes a \$20,000 scholarship.

Each year, the association awards 104 scholarships as part of its national scholarship program, according to the association's website.

Mouton, 17, said he plans to attend Prairie View A&M University. He said the university's music media program, as well its football team, attracted the Northside High fullback to the Texas school.

Mouton aspires to be a music producer and has a plan in place to achieve his goals.
